Treasure Dental Lab is an authorized Sirona in Lab Connect partner. We are now able to receive digital impressions from our doctors who have a Sirona Cerec system with the blue cam or omni cam. This makes it easy for you to take a scan of the patient and send that digital impression to us to fabricate the restoration.

Direct communication with your laboratory

The Sirona Connect software and the Sirona Connect portal simplify the cooperation between dental practice and laboratory. Once registered, both sides communicate directly through



the software. The data model is transferred within a few minutes and gives the laboratory an exact picture of the case.

The direct transmission of model data to our lab within a few minutes allows our dental technician to look at the case almost simultaneously with the practice. Thus, a first consultation with

our laboratory can already be done while the patient is still in the treatment room. Another advantage over conventional impression methods.

Atlantis Conus Concept



We are excited to offer you another great implant restorative choice for your edentulous patients. You take great care of your patients and they want you to provide a denture that can restore their ability to eat without it coming loose or hurting their gums.

They want a solution that allows them to speak with confidence and know they will not have a denture fall out. They want a natural looking smile that functions like real teeth.

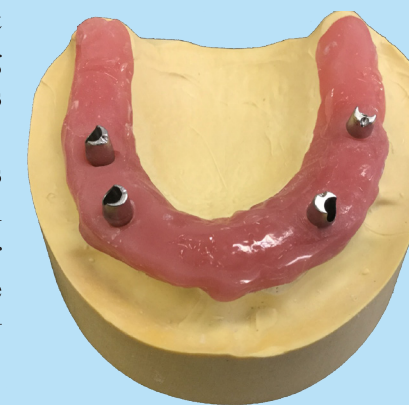
With Atlantis Conus concept, you can provide your patients all of these benefits at a very reasonable price. Unlike other removable solutions, The Atlantis Conus concept does not require plastic retention elements that can easily wear out over time, resulting in your patients coming back routinely for

replacement of parts. Fewer maintenance visits mean a higher level of patient convenience and satisfaction.

The added time saved also means greater productivity for new cases and more patients.

The way Conus works is by placing 4 or more implants per arch. We individually design the Conus abutments to be parallel to each other and place the restorative margins as close to the soft tissue as possible. The abutments have a 5 degree taper allowing the SynCone caps to have a precise friction fit that keeps the denture in place.

Your patients receive the benefits that both fixed and removable solutions have to offer. Friction-

retained abutments allow for removal of the prosthesis for better hygiene and easier maintenance, while delivering the added comfort and confidence of a fixed solution.

We fabricate a denture with an encapsulated metal framework to make it strong to withstand the forces of chewing and the daily routine of taking it in and out to clean.



With the denture fabricated, you will insert the Conus abutments with an insertion jig to make sure they are aligned correctly.

The denture will have holes where the SynCone caps will be cold-cured in place once the denture is lined up to fit the bite.

You will cover over the access hole and place the SynCone cape on top of the abutment then use either a rubber dam or SynCone polymerization sleeves to help prevent cold-cure polymer from

going down around the abutments. You cold-cure the denture in place just like you would with locators.
